Sheriff's Office Investigating Injury Crash on US Route 42

On Wednesday, October 10, 2018 at approximately 6:00 am, the Union County Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call reporting an injury crash at the intersection of US Route 42 and Jerome Road. Deputies and units from the Jerome Township Fire Department responded to the scene and found a 2013 Ford F-150 pick-up truck that was struck by a 2007 Kenworth semi. The semi traveled off the road and into a retention pond and became submerged. Additional emergency units from the Marysville Fire Department, the Washington Township Fire Department, and the Ohio State Highway Patrol responded to the scene. The driver of the semi was able to crawl on top of the semi cab and was rescued using a boat from the Marysville Fire Department. The driver of the semi has been identified as Randy C. Mayabb, age 52 of London. He was transported to Dublin Methodist Hospital. The driver of the Ford has been identified as Chad R. Carr, age 46 of Dublin. He was also transported to Dublin Methodist Hospital. The preliminary investigation has revealed the Ford F-150 was being driven westbound on Jerome Road and did not yield at the stop sign at US Route 42 and was struck by the northbound semi. The semi began to leak diesel fuel into the retention pond and the Union County Emergency Management Agency and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency were called to the scene. US Route 42 was closed from approximately 6:10 am until 8:40 am while the crash scene was cleared. The crash remains under investigation.
